



## Manistique Farmers' Market - Customer Requirements 2021

The Manistique Farmers' Market will open the 2021 season on Wednesday, June 2, 2021 from 4-6pm at Little Bear West Arena located at 180 N. Maple St. Manistique, MI 49854.

1. The Manistique Farmers' Market will maintain our status as a food and farm market only. This means that only the sale of produce, eggs, syrup, honey, cottage foods, pet supplies (with proper licensing), meats (must be packaged and stamped at a USDA processing plant), local fish, and vegetable plants are currently allowed to be sold at the Manistique Farmers' Market. **All foods must be grown, raised, and produced locally by the vendor.**
2. If you are fully vaccinated against COVID19 ("fully vaccinated" means at least 14 days have passed since your second dose of Moderna or Pfizer vaccines, or after a single dose of Johnson & Johnson), according to the CDC and the State of Michigan, you do not need to mask. Any customers who are unvaccinated or are not yet fully vaccinated, must wear a mask which fully covers your mouth and nose whether we are inside or outside. This will remain in place until July 1, 2021, and reviewed with State and Federal guidelines.
3. Though restrictions are being loosened at the State and Federal level, the SARS-CoV-2 virus which causes COVID is still in the region, including variants which the vaccines may not be as effective against. If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms, please do not come to the Market:
  - Fever
  - Cough
  - Shortness of breath
  - Sore throat
  - Recent loss of taste and or smell
4. Market vendors will be spread apart to allow six foot distances to be more easily maintained.
5. There will be no public access to restrooms.
6. Please limit the number of people in your group attending the Market to no more than two or three.
7. Do not come to the Market: If you have been ill, caring for someone that has been ill, or sharing a residence with someone that has been ill within the last 14 days.
8. Please be mindful to maintain at least 6 feet of distance between yourself, vendors, and other customers at all times.
9. Please leave your pets at home. Service dogs are allowed.
10. Please sanitize your hands upon entering and exiting the Market.
11. WIC Project Fresh, Senior Project Fresh will be accepted as payment for produce, in addition to cash. Project FRESH only covers fresh, locally grown, unprocessed produce. Sault Tribe YEA vouchers will be accepted for most Market products except wine.
12. All of these requirements are based on the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services guidelines, Public Health Guidelines and the Michigan Farmers' Market Association.
13. We will amend this document as things change with COVID requirements, including local spread and vaccination

levels.
